Candidates must have a BS in civil engineering or closely related field from an ABET-accredited program & a PhD in civil engineering with emphasis in geotechnical engineering. Experience & expertise in unsaturated soils, pavement materials, soil/ground improvements, and/or use/design of geosynthetics are desired secondary qualifications.
